COORDINATING PROVISIONS: STATE LAW,
ACCREDITATION STANDARDS AND GEOGRAPHIC EXCEPTIONS

I. INTRODUCTION:

- 1.1 Scope: To the extent of any conflict between the Agreement, including the administrative handbook as herein incorporated by reference, and this Exhibit, this Exhibit shall supersede, govern and control to the extent required by federal and/or state law and to the extent that MultiPlan, Inc., on behalf of itself and its subsidiaries (“MPI”), Provider and/or Client are subject to such federal or state law, including applicable District or federal law for covered persons who are in an active course of treatment or totally disabled; or
- (b) The date the contract between the carrier and the provider would have terminated if the carrier or intercarrier remained in force.
